Roe Goddard, Ph.D., associate professor of global studies at Thunderbird School of Global Management, is a global thought leader and educator with specialize expertise in international financial/monetary issues, globalization and strategic management, as well as the politics, economics and business culture of China.

With nearly three decades' experience in business and education, Dr. Goddard is highly regarded by students and executives. He is an instructor in Thunderbird's full-time and Executive MBA programs, and also plays a key role in numerous custom programs for global corporations. He has often been called upon to lead executive seminars, and he speaks to industry associations and executive meetings, covering all aspects of doing business in China and currency/financial risk.

Consulting extensively with a number of multinational corporations, Dr. Goddard has worked with companies including Bank of America Corp., General Electric, IBM, Lenovo, LG Electronics, Nike, Rockwell Automation, Philips, SK Group, Solar Turbines, AG Communications, Wiltel Communication, Boeing and Honeywell International.

Dr. Goddard has also written numerous articles and case studies, and served as managing editor of *International Studies Notes*, one of the premier journals of the International Studies Association. He is a member of the Academy of Management and the Academy of International Business. Additionally, Dr. Goddard has written case studies on China's economic-reform process and the management of manufacturing enterprises in China, country risk analysis and currency/financial crises, and he is conducting ongoing research on the valuation of the renminbi and Chinese financial-market liberalization.

Engaging some of his keen interests, Dr. Goddard teaches courses in executive development and personal productivity that receive some of Thunderbird's highest evaluations. Dr. Goddard has twice been awarded Most Valuable Professor distinction in Thunderbird's EMBA program. He has also taught at several universities in China, and is a senior adviser to the Chengdu Investment Promotion Commission in Chengdu, Sichuan province.
