



The Brian Bates Scholarship Award

History: Established in November 2000 in honor of Brian Andrew Bates, who served the Thunderbird community from 1988-August 2000 as Dean of Admissions, Vice President of Student Affairs, and Dean of Students. His generous service to the community and commitment to the student body motivated the Thunderbird Student Government to establish this scholarship in his name.

Criteria: Any student who has completed at least two trimesters at Thunderbird in the full-time MBA in International Management or the MIM program, who is currently enrolled, in good academic standing (3.0 GPA or better) and has demonstrated significant Thunderbird community involvement and leadership may apply.

Process: Students should submit a current resume and a 500-word essay on the value of their contribution to the Thunderbird community. The Scholarship Committee reviews the applications and selects the recipient. * * Recipient may be invited to attend a lunch with Brian Bates.
