



Karen and Gary Brukardt Costa Rica Scholarship

History: The scholarship was established in 2008 by Gary Brukardt, class of 1972 and a member of the Thunderbird Global Council, and his wife Karen Brukardt to support the efforts to build the Global MBA for Latin American Managers program in Costa Rica.

Criteria: Scholarships will be available to entering Global MBA students who:

1. Meet the School's general admissions requirements and have been offered admission through the Office of Admissions.
2. Meet the School's Entering Merit Scholarship Standards: an undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or higher, GMAT score of 600 or PAEP of 630 or higher.
3. Preference will be given to students who have shown commitment and outstanding performance in other areas of endeavor.
4. Live in Costa Rica and plan to participate in the Costa Rica program site (Master of Science in Global Management.)
