



Supply Chain Scholarship

Arizona Roundtable of the Council of Supply Chain Management Professionals

History: In August 2006, the Arizona Roundtable of the Council of Supply Chain Management Professionals (CSCMP AZ) established a new scholarship to support Thunderbird students in pursuit of a career in Supply Chain Management with a multinational company. CSCMP AZ is committed to doing its part in helping to develop Supply Chain professionals of the future.

Criteria:

- Candidate must be a continuing student in second trimester at Thunderbird.
- Candidate must be in good academic standing.
- Candidate must be enrolled for at least 12 credit hours.
- Candidate should have a demonstrated interest academically and/or previous work experience in Supply Chain Management.
- Student will be asked, but not required to participate in the CSCMP's AZ events, meetings and to introduce themselves in person to the CSCMP board. This participation will include being photographed for CSCMP's AZ newsletter articles and press releases.
- Recipient may be contacted directly by the CSCMP AZ board.

Process:

- Continuing students submit cover letter, current resume and a two-page double-spaced essay on their interest in pursuing a career in Supply Chain Management and how their degree at Thunderbird will enhance their career objectives.
- The Thunderbird Scholarship Committee selects the top candidates and forwards them to CSCMP AZ.
- CSCMP AZ will review and rank the applications and return their ranking to Thunderbird.
- Thunderbird's Scholarship Committee makes the final selection.
