



The Ena Craig De Luksic Foundation Scholarship

Criteria for Entering Students:

To be considered for the Ena Craig De Luksic Foundation Scholarship, prospective scholarship recipients must be accepted to study at Thunderbird into one of the following Thunderbird programs:

- MBA in Global Management
- Master of Science in Global Management
- Master of Arts in Global Affairs and Management
- Non-Degree Student Certificate Programs

Criteria for Continuing Students:

If no entering applicant meets the criteria, a continuing student, who meets the priority categories, may be considered with the following stipulations: The applicants must be in good standing, have completed one trimester at Thunderbird, and submit a two-page double-spaced essay describing why the candidate should receive the scholarship also, their interest in Latin America, and their past and future plans to do business in the region.

Priority Categories:

1. Qualified Chilean applicants who have graduated from Universidad Finis Terrae.
2. Qualified Chilean applicants who have graduated from Universidad Católica, Universidad de Chile, Universidad de los Andes or Universidad Adolfo Ibañez and who are employed by Grupo Luksic.
3. Other qualified applicants from Chile.
4. Qualified applicants from Latin America.

Process: Thunderbird and UFT will work together to select the recipient of the scholarship.

- UFT and Thunderbird will promote the availability of the scholarship in the Chilean national press, in the local Santiago newspapers, in both UFT and Thunderbird alumni publications and websites, and with the Santiago chapter of the Thunderbird Alumni Association. Flyers and posters may also be developed

and placed in Chilean universities. The two institutions will work together to ensure that brand and design standards are appropriate.

- Those who are interested will contact UFT for more information regarding the eligible Thunderbird programs and the Luksic Scholarship. Representatives from UFT will provide candidates with admissions information and will conduct a preliminary screening.
- All interested candidates will send their admission applications directly to Thunderbird for consideration.
- The Thunderbird Admissions Committee will review all admission applications. Of those accepted, the top eligible candidates for the Luksic scholarship will be forwarded to UFT for their review and recommendation.
- UFT will select the most appropriate scholarship candidate/s and present them to Mr. Guillermo Luksic.
- Upon Mr. Luksic's approval, Thunderbird will advise the chosen candidate of the scholarship offer.

Award Amount: Presidential Scholarship- Full tuition, plus stipend.
