



Thunderbird Chapter NAWMBA Scholarship

History: This scholarship was established by the Thunderbird Chapter of the National Association of Women MBA's to encourage students with leadership experience to continue with their leadership on the Thunderbird campus community. Scholarship is offered to help with educational expenses, to include tuition and other related expenses.

Criteria: For continuing students. Preference given to women; however, if no qualified woman is found then men will be considered. Candidate must have strong leadership potential.

- Students in their second, third or fourth term are eligible to apply
- Students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better.
- Students must submit to Financial Aid: current resume plus a one-page double-spaced essay addressing the following: Their leadership on campus and/or in local community.

Process: The Thunderbird Scholarship Committee reviews all applications and selects the top candidates.
