



Thunderbird Global Council Scholarship

History: This fund was started in July of 2006 from gifts from members of the Thunderbird Global Council (TGC) and be maintained with ongoing annual gifts from TGC members.

Criteria: Scholarships will be available to entering students who:

- Meet the School's general admission requirements and have been offered admission through the Office of Admissions.
- Meet the School's Entering Merit Scholarship Standards -- a minimum of two years work experience, the nature of which would enable to student to bring input of value to onstruction in the program of choice; an undergraduate GPA of 3.2 or higher, GMAT score of 630 of higher or the equivalent on the GRE scoring protocol.
- Preference will be given to students who have shown commitment and outstanding performance in other areas of endeavor.

Process:

- The Thunderbird Scholarship Committee reviews all applications and selects the top candidates.
- Once awarded, a report of the selected students will be made to the TGC leadership and to donating members.
