



Bill and Mary Kay Post Scholarship

History: Thunderbird Board of Trustee member William J. Post and his wife Mary Kay, along with the APS Foundation, established this endowed scholarship in July 2010 to support Arizona residents in any full-time degree program at Thunderbird.

Criteria: The scholarship will make an annual award(s) to students from available funds generated by the endowment in accordance with the school's endowment policy. Awards will be made to students meeting the following criteria established by the donor:

- Applicants may be entering or continuing students with demonstrated financial need.
- Applicants may be applying for or enrolled in any full-time masters program at Thunderbird.
- Applicants must meet the School's general admission requirements and have been offered admission through the Office of Admissions.
- Applicants must be an Arizona resident at the time of application. If no Arizona residents apply for the scholarship, students from other states or countries will be considered.

Process: Eligible candidates meeting the criteria above will be identified and reviewed by the Thunderbird Scholarship Committee who will select scholarship recipients. Students receiving scholarship awards will send a thank you letter to Mr. and Mrs. Post through the Development Office at Thunderbird. Annually, Mr. and Mrs. Post will receive a report with the balance of the endowment as well as the amount and number of the awards made.
